National Security Council Endorses Local Police Force Establishment

July 14, 2010

President Karzai chaired Wednesday a security meeting to discuss the proposal to create a new police force unit, named as Local Police Force, within the Ministry of Interior.

The meeting participated by both the Vice-presidents, senior security officials including the Ministers of Interior and Education, National Security Advisor, chief of the NDS, chiefs of the IDLG and Office of Administration Affairs, top NATO commander and US Ambassador to Afghanistan discussed in details the proposal to form a local police force unit within the structure of the Ministry of Interior.

The proposal was presented by Interior Minister Gen. Bismillah Mohammadi and President's Advisor on Security Affairs, Masoom Estnekzai.

The meeting agreed on several aspects of the proposal including the creation of the LPF under the MoI authority and direct control.

It was also agreed that for the purpose of the rule of law, all armed groups outside the Interior Ministry be gradually disbanded and then be re-integrated into the Local Police Force as and where necessary.

The meeting decided that the Interior Minister prepare a report on the details of the organizational structure for the new Local Police Force in the next meeting of the national Security Council.
