President Karzai offers condolences to UN Secretary-General and President Zardari

H.E. President Hamid Karzai in a telephone call Thursday night offered his condolences to United Nations Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon over the death of 6 UN staff members in Wednesday's terrorist attack in Kabul.

President Karzai assured UN Secretary-General that the government of Afghanistan would do its utmost to provide better security for the UN staff serving in Afghanistan.

Secretary-General Ban Ki-moon thanked President Karzai for his sympathy and stressed that such terrorist acts would not stop the UN mission in Afghanistan.

President Hamid Karzai also telephoned Pakistani President Asif Ali Zardari on Thursday night and condoled with him the death of nearly 100 people in Wednesday's bombing in Peshawar, Pakistan.
